

Laser is an acronym for Light Amplification by Stimulated Emission of Radiation. That's great but what does that actually mean?

Lasers are simply beams of light that have different targets. The wavelengths of the light beam can be varied to effect different targets. The most common targets are blood, water, and pigment. The skin essentially acts as a window allowing the light to pass thru to reach its intended target. Once the target is reached the light beam is absorbed by the target and is converted to heat which destroys the specific target.

The most common "target" we use the laser for in our office is to reduce unwanted hair, eradicate blood vessels on the face and certain ones on the legs, treat brown spots, erase tattoos, and tighten and tone the skin of the face.
